## ADVANCED MANUFACTURING

Planning, managing, and processing materials into products and related activities such as production planning and control, maintenance, and manufacturing/process engineering.



## COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS

Earn transcripted college credit while attending MVCTC by taking college courses from community colleges or universities. The program aims to promote rigorous academic pursuits and allow college-ready students to jump-start their college studies while in high school.



## BUILDING & CONSTRUCTION

Designing, planning, managing, building, and maintaining the built environment. Individuals in these careers work on buildings and other structures. This includes highways, bridges, houses, and buildings. They might create designs or plans for new structures. Or, they might use the plans to build or manage the workers on the construction projects.



## WORK-BASED LEARNING

Work-based learning experiences are conducted at a job during school. They are designed to provide authentic learning experiences to students that link academic, technical, and professional skills. Business partners work with MVCTC to evaluate and supervise the experience, which must be documented with learning agreements.



## AGRICULTURE

Production, processing, marketing, distribution, financing, and development of agricultural commodities and resources, including food, fiber, wood products, natural resources, horticulture, and other plant and animal products/resources.



## ARTS & COMMUNICATION

Designing, producing, exhibiting, writing, and publishing multimedia content, including visual arts and design, and photography.



## BUSINESS

Planning, organizing, directing, and evaluating business functions essential to efficient and productive business operations.



## HUMAN SERVICES

Preparing individuals for employment in career pathways that relate to families and human needs, such as family and community services, personal care, and consumer services.



## TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS

Support services such as management, logistics services, mobile equipment and facility maintenance.



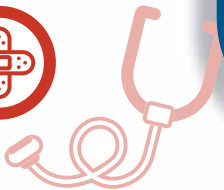
## INDUSTRY CERTIFICATIONS

## **Career Connections is a new, unique experience at MVCTC for students in grades 10, 11 & 12!**

Career Connections students will select from multiple rotations in different fields to provide a broad exposure to potential careers pathways.

Career Connections goals:

- Expose students to potential careers through in-depth career-technical experiences
- Provide guidance and individualized academic support to ensure credits are acquired for graduation
- Develop study skills, and participate in employability education.

### **Program Overview:**

- Acceptance to Career Connections will be limited. If more applications are received than available seats, a lottery system will be used to determine acceptance offers.
- Ideally, the student enrolling in Career Connections is comfortable in an online, asynchronous academic learning environment with in-person instructor support provided.
- Career Connections is not recommended for students taking Pre-Calculus or higher math.
- Please note, if a student has three credit deficiencies or more at the end of their freshman year, it is recommended that they apply for Youth Connections and not Career Connections.

# YOUTH CONNECTIONS

Youth Connections provides many students the best chance to obtain a high school diploma if they have failed to succeed at their partner school. Classes are aligned with the Ohio Department of Education Content Standards. The curriculum is competency-based, not seat-time-based. This program is best for students:

- Disconnected from school due to non-attendance or an inability to succeed in a regular school setting
- Lacking credits
- Deficient in the areas emphasized in the State of Ohio-mandated graduation tests
- Under expulsion for any reasons will be dealt with case by case

### **Program Overview:**

- Instruction in a small personal setting with a great deal of flexibility and a curriculum that will allow students to receive their high school diploma and gain skills necessary to lead to long-term employment.
- Career Based Intervention (CBI) program.
- Students work at their own individual pace, not at the speed of the class.
- The majority of the coursework is completed on the computer, and instructors serve as individual tutors for the students.
- Students must have at least an 80% mastery of every single objective in each class to receive credit for the class, and each student has a schedule that will meet their specific requirements for graduation.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ'S)



## 1. What is the daily schedule at MVCTC?

MVCTC's school day is 8:05 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. We have eight class periods a day that are 40 minutes long. Students spend about 1/2 of their day in their career tech lab and take academic/elective classes to meet their graduation requirements for the other part of their day.

## 2. Do I have to have my own transportation every day?

MVCTC's 27 partner schools provide transportation. Work-Based Learning students must provide their own daily transportation. The Dayton RTA does have a daily route to MVCTC.

## 3. Will I earn my high school diploma from MVCTC?

Students can earn eight credits each year at MVCTC; credits are awarded by semester. Students receive their high school diploma from their partner schools. In addition, MVCTC gives students a career passport showing their professional and personal accomplishments after completing the program.

## 4. Can I still go to college if I attend MVCTC?

MVCTC prepares students for both careers and college. Students have several opportunities to earn college credit and scholarship money to help them prepare for post-secondary education.

## 5. Can I still participate in sports at my partner school?

Students are still enrolled at their partner school while attending MVCTC. Students are encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities at their partner school, activities permitted vary based on the partner school.

**OPTION 1: INTERNSHIP** - An internship is a temporary position emphasizing on-the-job training rather than merely employment, and it can be paid or unpaid.

**OPTION 2: PRE-APPRENTICESHIP** - MVCTC has an Ohio State Apprenticeship Council Recognized Pre-Apprenticeship Program. Students learn the skills needed for a rewarding career while earning a paycheck – all without racking up student loan debt. The students who meet the qualifications can start work the summer before their senior year and when school starts. They can work two weeks full-time and return to school two weeks full-time to complete their academic requirements for graduation. Students can also do a Pre-Apprenticeship position for half of their school

day. They would attend MVCTC for half of the school day to complete their academic requirements. Students who complete the Pre-Apprenticeship Program will earn a 12-point credential towards their graduation requirements.

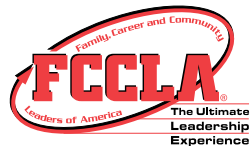
**OPTION 3: ADVANCED PLACEMENT** - Students in all career technical programs that participate will seek employment in the second semester of their senior year. The student's GPA and attendance will determine their Advanced Placement start date. These students will work a half-day with a qualified employer, which counts towards their career-technical program grade.

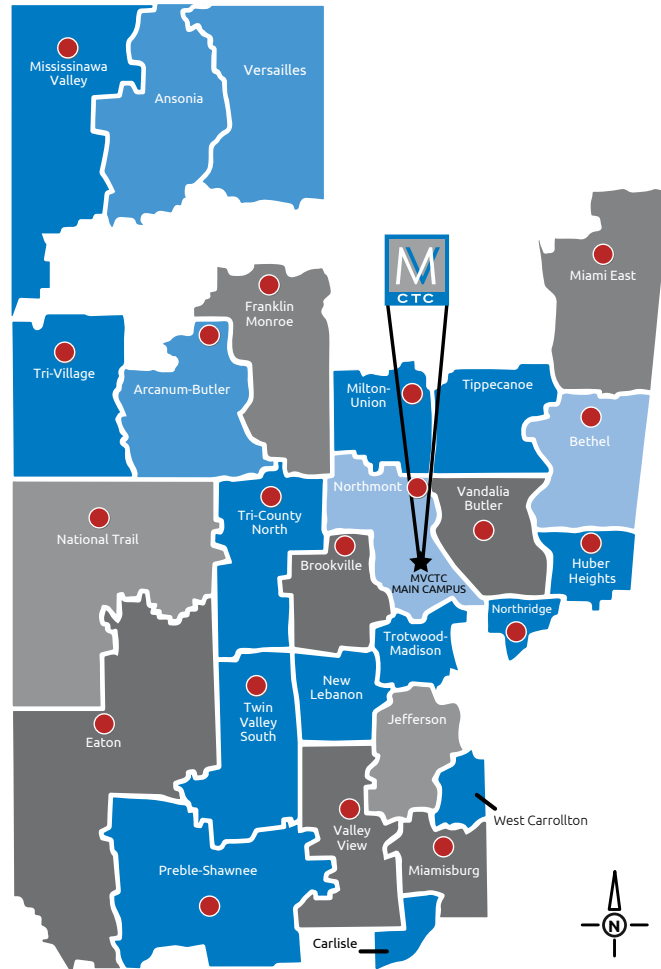
# MVCTC PARTNER SCHOOL DISTRICTS
