



Dual Enrollment Program

The MVCTC and Miami University of Middletown (MUM) are partnering to deliver college courses on the MVCTC campus during the school day.

Dual enrollment is **not** PSEO. Dual enrollment allows students the opportunity to remain on the MVCTC campus, take a college level course, and earn **both** high school and college credit. When a student is enrolled as a dual-enrollment student, s/he is also a student at the college, where they will have the same benefits as any other Miami University Middletown student.

Math and Science – Miami University of Middletown

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for Miami University dual credit courses, students must have:

- 2.5 or greater GPA
- Successful completion of the COMPASS test with an appropriate placement score
- Meet reading proficiency requirements
- Completion of the college application process
- Parent permission
- Willingness to accept the challenge and rigor of a college course and to study accordingly
- Willingness to pay reduced tuition for the course (Currently, \$103.31 per semester hour)
- If the student does not pass or withdraws after a pre-determined date there will be a \$45 per semester hour fee that the student will need to reimburse MVCTC to cover the tuition reduction, in addition to the tuition already paid.

PHY 171 (3 sem hrs) / Lab PHY 183 (1 sem hr) College Physics/ 1st semester

PHY 172 (3 sem hrs) / Lab PHY 184 (1 sem hr) College Physics/ 2nd semester

COMPASS testing will take place on the MVCTC campus in our Testing Center located in the South building.
