Senior Recognition Speakers

Any senior who wishes to be chosen to deliver a speech at Senior Recognition must submit a typed speech for consideration to his/her career-technical instructor by 2:30 p.m. on Friday, April 13, 2012. Speeches are to be no longer than two (2) minutes in length and must be on one of the following topics:

1. My future as a CTC graduate
2. Why I selected the CTC and why it was the right choice
3. How my family and the staff at the CTC have helped me be a success

Students may submit speeches for consideration on one or all of the above topics. During week of April 16, students who have submitted a written speech will receive further instructions.

A panel of instructors will review speeches and tryouts will be scheduled the last week of April or the first week of May.

Speeches selected for presentation at Senior Recognition must be delivered as written.

No handwritten speeches will be considered.

Students interested must be in the MVCTC class of 2012 and meet qualifications for receiving an invitation to Sr. Recognition ceremony:

- 1.5 GPA or above for all classes
- 93% attendance (25 or fewer absences)
- Completion of Sr. Work Experience requirements
- All fees and financial obligations to MVCTC must be paid in full
