

OGT Intervention

Intervention classes are designed to prepare students to pass the Ohio Graduation Test. Upon completing intervention, students who have completed at least 10 hours per subject area will take a summer test at MVCTC on June 23.

The MVCTC will test qualified students enrolled in the above described intervention program. Students not enrolled in the MVCTC intervention program may test on the designated date only if they have completed a summer school intervention program and have had prior written approval of this program from their high school and the MVCTC summer school principal. Students must include their SSID# and present a valid Ohio Drivers License (or Birth Certificate) at registration – positive proof of identification necessary for test.

Should a situation occur in which an OGT Intervention Class is full, priority will be given to accepted MVCTC students
