MVCTC Legal Assisting Students Visit Ohio Supreme Court

Columbus, Ohio – The Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC) Legal Assisting students recently visited the Ohio Supreme Court to observe first-hand the legal process in the State of Ohio. Legal Assisting students, accompanied by instructors Ms. Mandy Fetters and Mrs. Kelly Haws, were able to review samples cases in the Education Center, act out fictitious juvenile court cases, observe an Ohio Supreme Court hearing, and meet with Chief Justice Moyer's assistant. Chief Justice Moyer's assistant shared her career path with the students and the education and employment history necessary to reach her current position. Ms. Fetters said of the trip, "(It was) a great experience that allowed our legal students to see the law in action. It brought to life what we are learning in class!"

A student in the MVCTC Legal Assisting Program will learn highly skilled training such as office technology, law office procedures, legal terminology accounting, and records management for an in demand career field.
