MVCTC HVAC Student Puts His Skills to the Test

Clayton, Ohio – Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC) Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) program senior, Josh Moody, recently created a sheet metal ball in lab. Josh, from New Lebanon, created the ball after Mr. Routzohn discussed in class that a well-trained sheet metal worker could make a ball out of sheet metal. Josh mentioned this to his fellow workers at Drake Heating & Air, one of whom then challenged Josh to make the ball. Josh asked Mr. Routzohn for permission to make the sheet metal ball as a special lab project. The ball is made out of 26-gauge sheet metal and is 10 inches in diameter.
