## STEM<sup>2</sup> Camp – June 22-26, 2009, 8:30 a.m. – 3 p.m. each day.

STEM<sup>2</sup> Camp is for students entering the 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade with an interest in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). STEM is an approach to learning that involves problem solving and critical thinking. Students

can select two programs out of six offered and will be able to spend a full day exploring these career areas. Highly qualified math, science, career-technical instructors, and current students will work with the campers in the MVCTC labs to develop exciting projects. ### Math Machines Workshop - August 3-7, 2009, 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. with a oneday follow-up in November 2009.

This camp is for teachers (grades 7-12) of Math, Science, or Technology in MVCTC Partner School Districts who want to use authentic real-world activities in their classrooms. The camp is sponsored by the Martha Holden Jennings Foundation and in cooperation with Sinclair Community College and with support from Vernier Software and Technology. Participants will build their own Algebraically Controlled Vehicle (ACV) and two other "math machines" for use in their classroom. They will learn to use the ACV and other materials in activities where students apply mathematics and science concepts to authentic, workrelated tasks. The ACV and other math machines give an immediate, physical expression to free-form algebraic functions. Preference will be given to teams of teachers who can continue to collaborate during the school year. No prior experience with computer programming or electronics is required!
