The Medial Assisting program is a full-time, 30-week, 900-hour program, which prepares adult students to work in medical offices and clinics. The program includes classes in Anatomy and Physiology, medical terminology, communications, office procedures, medical skills, CPR, and pharmacology. Graduates from the Medical Assisting program had to complete a 192-hour externship and may be eligible to take the certification exam to earn the title Certified Medical Assistant (CMA).

The Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) program at MVCTC is approved by the Ohio Board of Nursing and is either completed as full-time classes, 41-weeks over 11months, or taken as part-time classes, over 22-months. This program prepares students for professional licensure and employment as a Licensed Practical Nurse. Following successful completion of the MVCTC LPN courses, students are eligible to sit for the National Certification and Licensing Exam (NCLEX-PN).

MVCTC is committed to helping citizens of the Miami Valley find success in the job market, even a job market in turmoil. Current construction projects will allow for the expansion of MVCTC Adult Education programs, especially in the health care field.
