MVCTC Students Receive H1N1 Vaccination

Clayton, Ohio – Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC) worked with the Montgomery County Health Department to provide the H1N1 flu vaccines for MVCTC students in the target at-risk group of getting this type of flu. The vaccine was available from the Montgomery County Health Department for any current MVCTC student at no charge. On Thursday, November 12, 2009, the vaccinations were voluntarily given to students with signed parental permission forms. Registered nurses on the MVCTC teaching staff and representatives from the Montgomery County Health Department administered close to 700 vaccinations to MVCTC students.
