MVCTC Adult Ed Nursing Students Share Knowledge

Clayton, Ohio – Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC) Adult Education Licensed Practical Nursing (LPN) students held a "High School Interactive Health Fair" for the high school students attending MVCTC. The health fair was April 20, 2010, in the MVCTC Media Center and sponsored by the MVCTC Wellness Center. The health fair was an informative, interactive event with multiple booths addressing health care topics of interest to teens. Adult Education LPN students worked the booths and shared information on the different health topics with visiting students. The over-all goal was to promote wellness in the MVCTC high school and the hope is to make this an annual event.

The Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) program at MVCTC is approved by the Ohio Board of Nursing and is either completed as full-time classes, 41-weeks over 11months, or taken as part-time classes, over 22-months. This program prepares students for professional licensure and employment as a Licensed Practical Nurse. Following successful completion of the MVCTC LPN courses, students are eligible to sit for the National Certification and Licensing Exam (NCLEX-PN).

MVCTC is committed to helping citizens of the Miami Valley find success in the job market, even a job market in turmoil. The new MVCTC Adult Education Center opened in Clayton this past October and allowed for the expansion of Adult Education programs, especially in the health care field.
