MVCTC FCCLA Students Bound for California

Charlotte, NC – Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC) students from the Family, Career, and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) Chapter participated in the Family and Consumer Sciences Knowledge Bowl in Charlotte, NC and placed high enough to earn a spot at the National Competition in July.

The winning MVCTC FCCLA team included Jordyn Doles (Brookville), Alysha Hammaker (Tri-County North), Kaylee Howard (New Lebanon), Julieann Silva (Valley View), and Christy Stonerock (Tri-County North).

The Knowledge Bowl event required team members to complete an online test of general Family and Consumer Sciences questions in September. The top five scores of each chapter were averaged to determine a *Chapter Score*. The top three chapters from Ohio and all chapters with a *chapter score* above 90% were invited to Level 2 at the National Cluster Meeting in Charlotte, NC.

The Level 2 competition in Charlotte included a written test. Each team was given a test packet containing five tests, one in each of the following areas: Family, Career, & Community Studies; Early Childhood & Human Development; Food Sciences, Dietetics, & Nutrition; Hospitality, Tourism, & Recreation; and Fashion & Housing Design. The teams with the top 20 scores advanced to the next level.

The Level 3 competition was a single elimination, head-to-head competition. Teams were put into a bracket with winners of the first round continuing to the next round. The five winners advanced to Level 4, which will take place at the National Leadership Conference in Anaheim, CA in July.
