Greater Dayton Area Hospital Association President Visits MVCTC

Mr. Bucklew met with MVCTC Superintendent, Dr. John Boggess; MVCTC Adult Education Supervisor, Mrs. Amy Leedy; MVCTC Adult Education Nursing Supervisor, Mrs. Lynn Beaver, and MVCTC Secondary Health and Consumer Sciences Supervisor, Mrs. Ann Patton.
