MVCTC Adult Education Offers GED Classes at Sinclair Community College

Dayton, Ohio – The Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC) offers a GED Class at Sinclair Community College in the Academic Resource Center (ARC). The class is offered Monday – Thursday from 9 a.m. until 1 p.m. each day. The class is in a computer lab at Sinclair and uses various software as well as individual tutoring. Each student is placed on an individual learning plan that is driven by student goals. Once the GED is attained, the student is directed into the next phase college. The transition from GED into college is seamless. Once the student starts college, the mentoring process begins. The mentoring process can last as long as the student needs it with the goal being to help the student be successful. The GED/ARC classroom is welcoming and positive with a fast track approach to student success!

The GED/ARC Class has 70 students that have progressed one or more grade levels in reading or math. The class has 26 students who have passed the GED Test and received their High School Equivalency Diplomas. Of the 26 students who have their GED, 16 have entered post-secondary education at Sinclair Community College. MVCTC GED Coordinator, Linda Bumiller, says of the GED/ARC classes at Sinclair, "Students are changing their lives in this class, the transformation is awesome to observe!"
