MVCTC Adult Education Offers Dining Assistant Program

Clayton, Ohio - Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC) Adult Education Dining Assistant classes are scheduled to start May 23, 2011. This is a cost effective 1½ day program designed to cross train personnel and volunteers in long term care facilities, or to add skills to students resumes.

The program is designed to prepare individuals to assist in the dining room of long-term care facilities during mealtime, when there is a need for increased staff. The initial portion will consist of ten hours, and will be a combination of classroom and laboratory experience to participate in hands on activities. There will also be a one-hour clinical component, during which students will feed residents in a long-term care facility.

The topics to be covered are a dining assistant overview, communication, and interpersonal skills. In addition, topics include infection control, safety and emergency preparedness, resident rights, nutrition, fluid needs, and mealtime. The program is approved by the Ohio Department of Health with a State issued Certificate.
