The MVCTC Adult Education Carpentry, Electrician, and HVAC programs are all Full Time programs offered at the MVCTC campus in Clayton. All three programs are designed for both current and future skilled trade's personnel.

- The Carpentry program is a 36-week, 648-hour program, with the next session starting on September 26, 2011.
- The Electrician program is a 38-week, 646-hour program, with the next session starting on September 12, 2011.
- The HVAC program is a 38-week, 646-hour program, with the next session starting on September 26, 2011.
