## MVCTC Student, Brianna Cook, Earns Scholarship

**Clayton, Ohio** – Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC) Medical Office Management senior, Brianna Cook (Trotwood- Madison) earned a \$6,000 scholarship to attend the University of Northwestern Ohio. The University of Northwestern Ohio had a Senior Scholarship Test with over 250 participants. The first place student in the test received a full ride, second place received a \$6,000 scholarship, and third place received \$3,500. Brianna took the Office Technology Test in October, placed second, and received a \$6,000 dollar scholarship to attend the University of Northwestern Ohio.

MVCTC Medical Office Management instructor, Mr. Rusty Sink, said of Brianna's success, "I am very excited for Brianna and hope this will help her reach her goals of attending college".

The MVCTC Medical Office Management program gives high school students practical experience on how the administrative section of a medical office works. From private practices to large hospitals, a competent office administrator ensures that patient information is accurate, billing is correct, maintains records, and schedules appointments to maximize the efficiency of the office. The MVCTC Medical Office Management students run a simulated medical office to experience scheduling appointments on the computer, maintaining patient records, and corresponding with insurers, patients and other medical facilities. In addition to hands-on administrative projects, students earn their CPR certification and participate in video broadcasts of medical procedures.

The Medical Office Management program at MVCTC is a Tech Prep program, which means all students meeting specific criteria may be eligible for college credit and scholarship money towards Sinclair Community College.
