The team of James Benedict (Arcanum) and Seth Johnson (Twin Valley South) placed first out of 17 teams at the district contest and qualified to compete at the State FFA contest held on March 8, at the University of Northwestern Ohio (UNOH) in Lima.

The Agricultural Industrial Diagnostics Contest requires students to use the knowledge learned from their career technical program to trouble shoot various pieces of equipment including tractors, lift trucks, and mini excavators. The students had 20-minutes to use a systematic procedure to find and repair two malfunctions based on information provided by the customer.
