**MVCTC Culinary Arts Students Accepted to Johnson & Wales Honors Programs**

**Clayton, Ohio** – Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC) Culinary Arts seniors Briana Kimberlin (Brookville) and Esco Reeder (Northridge) have both been accepted to Johnson & Wales University honors programs that will start this June.

Briana was accepted into the Johnson & Wales Baking and Pastry Honors Program that starts in June. It is an 11-week program that includes a \$36,000 scholarship. After Briana completes the summer program, she will start the fall at Johnson & Wales as a college sophomore.

Esco was accepted into the Johnson & Wales Culinary Arts Honors Program also starts in June. His 11-week program also includes a \$36,000 scholarship towards a four year degree and will allow him to start college in the fall as a sophomore. This is close to a \$20,000 savings for both students.
