This simulation equips middle and high school students throughout Ohio with \$100,000 in "imaginary funds" to manage a hypothetical portfolio of stocks, bonds and mutual funds over a ten-week period. Using state-of-the-art software, students researched and traded in real-time using the latest available bid/ask prices from the market.

Out of 110 teams in the Dayton region, MVCTC students placed 1st and 2nd.

Students attended an awards luncheon at Wright State University hosted by Dean Joanne Li of the Raj Soin College of Business. They also received cash prizes (\$100 -1st place, \$75 - 2nd), goodie bags, enjoyed a rock-wall climbing session and toured the campus.
