In a few short weeks, MVCTC will have students attend academic and some career-technical classes in a portion of the new remodeled and expanded building! In order to ensure that the instructors, support staff and administrators are fully prepared for the transition, MVCTC main campus and Youth Connections students **will not be on campus from Wednesday, November 23 through Friday, December 2**.
