Introduction

The Miami County Master Gardeners will be awarding \$1000 scholarships to graduating seniors pursuing higher education in an agricultural field.

Qualifications

- Must be a 2024 graduating senior and resident of Miami County.
- Must have applied as a full-time student to a four-year college/university or a two-year technical school for fall of 2024.
- Must plan to study agriculture, horticulture, environmental science, natural resources, conservation or have plans to be an educator in one of these fields.

Conditions of the Scholarship

The award will be used towards the student's tuition and fees and will be processed through the scholarship/admissions office of the chosen school. A schedule of classes or tuition statement from the college/university/technical school will need to be provided for the award to be applied.

Selection

The selection of the final applicants will be made by the Miami County Master Gardener Volunteers.
