Interested seniors must have a clean discipline record and be on track to meet the following requirements for participation in the Senior Recognition ceremony:

- At minimum, a 1.5 cumulative GPA
- At minimum, a 93% daily attendance rate
- Successful completion of the MVCTC Senior Mandatory Work Experience Program
- All fees and financial obligations to MVCTC met

Interested seniors who wish to be considered must submit a typed speech to Mr. Winner by 2:30 p.m. on **March 17, 2023**.

Speeches are to be no longer than two minutes in length and must be on one of the following topics:

1. My future as a MVCTC graduate...
2. Why I selected the MVCTC and why it was the right choice....
3. How my family, friends and the staff at the MVCTC have helped me achieve/prepare for success....

A panel of instructors will review the submissions and select students for further consideration. Students selected for further consideration will be contacted with additional instructions in early April.

Speeches selected for presentation at the MVCTC Senior Recognition ceremony must be delivered as written.
